

Footwear Suggestions for Orthoses

This is a list of suggestions, not recommendations. In most cases, you should not go more than one shoe size larger. If you are having trouble you may have to seek a different style, not size.

Shoe Characteristics to use with orthoses:

- Flat external sole
- Laces/tongue opening that extends to the toes
- Removable insole
